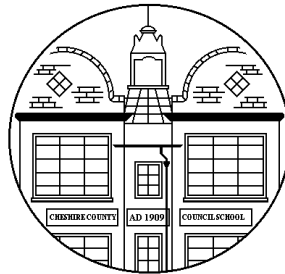

Cambridge Road Out of School Club

The club is run during school time only and is available for all pupils who attend Cambridge Road CP & N School.

Times of Opening and Charges:

Mornings: 8.00 a.m. - 8.55 a.m.

£2 per session which includes breakfast of cereal, toast and a drink.

No booking is required.

Afternoons: 3.00 p.m. - 5.30 p.m.

£5.50 per FULL session which includes a snack and drink.

£3.50 if collected BEFORE 4.30 p.m.

Booking is required.

After School Club Care Charges

Child going straight to after school care club -

- If the child is picked up before 3.30 p.m. - £2.00
- If the child is picked up before 4.30pm - £3.50
- If the child is picked up before 5.30 p.m. - £5.50
- If you have more than 1 child at the club it is 50p per child less

Child going straight to an extra-curricular club (e.g. football) before going to after school care club -

- If the child is picked up before 4.30 p.m. - £1.50
- If the child is picked up before 5.30 - £3.50
- If you are more than a child at the club it is 50p per child less

Child picked up after 5.25pm but before 5.45pm there is a late charge of £5.00 per child.

Child picked up after 5.25pm but after 5.45pm there is a late charge of £10 per child.

Activity weeks' to remain at £10.00 per child if picked up before 4.30 p.m.

Children enter school through the Learning Centre entrance for breakfast club from 8.00 a.m. onwards.

All KS1 children are collected from their classrooms at the end of the school day and escorted to the Learning Centre. KS2 children make their own way to the Learning Centre at 3.10 p.m.

Children are collected from the Learning Centre at the end of each session.

Every child is encouraged to participate in all the activities and a child's preference and not gender or ability will be the deciding factor in what the child decides to do.

We have arranged the club to provide both stimulating and fun activities. A quiet area is provided for those who do not wish to be quite so active. The following activities will be available at various times:
